All 3 camps are Monday-Friday 9:00-4:00 with a FREE final performance on Friday evening for family and friends at 7:00pm. Before and after care will be available for an additional fee. Before care from 7:30-9:00am is an additional \$15.00 per week and aftercare from 4:00--5:30pm is an additional \$15.00 per week.

Each camp will present a new mini-musical. The campers will perform all tasks involved in producing a musical. They will start their week with activities that will allow the staff and other campers to get to know the participants. Next will be the audition process. During lunch on the first day the staff will cast the show. The afternoon begins the rehearsal process. Over the next 3 days the campers will learn the music, choreography, and dialogue. They will participate in making the sets, props, and costume pieces. Some will even help with the marketing materials to invite their families.
